## Introduction

Billions of people still face pervasive poverty, gross inequalities, joblessness, environmental degradation, food insecurity, climate change, diseases and pandemics. Statistical evidences point to the fact that 78% of the world's poorest people live in rural areas and 95% of the rural poor live in East Asia, South Asia and sub-Saharan Africa. A large share of the new extreme poor will be concentrated in countries that are already struggling with high poverty rates and numbers of poor. Almost half of the projected new poor will be in South Asia, and more than a third in Sub-Saharan Africa. Persistent, and widespread hunger and malnutrition remain a huge challenge in many parts of the world, especially in Africa and Asia. Many people lack adequate water and sanitation, and many children are in poor health and lack quality education opportunities. Vulnerability to shocks is enormous as substantial because numerous households live in risky environments. Thus, rural development and poverty alleviation, despite being a priority agenda in the national development strategies and a major destination of donor support in the past decades, continue to remain major challenges in most of the developing countries.

The world leaders, while adopting the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, resolved to free humanity from poverty, secure a healthy planet for future generations and build peaceful, inclusive societies as a foundation for ensuring lives of dignity for all through a universal set of 17 goals and 169 targets. This collective journey has at its heart a promise to leave no one behind. AARDO's mission and interventions corroborate extensively, if not comprehensively, with the UN 2030 Agenda and its 17 Sustainable Development Goals.
